


As Pro Se Plaintiff in ***Robert Allen McNeil v Commissioner of Internal Revenue***, please consider this letter my official notice that I wish to drop the referenced case and have it removed from the docket of the U. S. Tax Court.

I make this request because it has come to my attention that acts of fraud are alleged to have been committed by 15 Internal Revenue Operations Managers and Agents against millions of U. S. Citizens.

On March 31, 2006, I filed a Criminal Complaint with the F.B.I. for the purpose of providing probable cause for the start of an investigation and/or the issuance of arrest warrants and subsequent prosecution of the Named Accused. Joining me were thousands of other citizens who did the same.

Since the outcome of this investigation and/or subsequent trial directly affects the facts and issues relevant to my case, I request that the Internal Revenue take no further action against me until those issues are resolved in Federal Court.
