


AFFIDAVIT OF DEFAULT
TO
CONSTRUCTIVE NOTICE OF FRAUD

BEFORE ME, the undersigned Notary, Amber Fleet, on this 7th day of November, 2007, personally appeared Robert A. McNeil, known to me to be a credible person and of lawful age, who being by me first duly sworn, on his oath, deposes and says that:

- On October 24, 2007, he sent by Certified Mail, the attached "**Constructive Notice of Fraud**" to Mr. Roger Caris, Revenue Officer, Department of the Treasury, Internal Revenue Service, and Mr. R. Scott Shieldes, Special Assistant U.S. Attorney, U.S. Department of Justice, and;
- He received two, green, U. S. Postal Service "Domestic Return Receipts" indicating that the "**Constructive Notice of Fraud**" was received in Mr. Caris' and Mr. Shieldes' offices on October 25, 2007, and;
- The "**Constructive Notice of Fraud**" required Mr. Caris and Mr. Shieldes to admit to or deny certain facts related to the application of the Federal Income Tax laws within ten (10) days from October 24, 2007, and;
- The "**Constructive Notice of Fraud**" informed Mr. Caris and Mr. Shieldes that their failure to provide the required information within ten (10) days from October 24, 2007 would be construed as legal evidence of fraud, and;
- Mr. Caris and Mr. Shieldes failed to respond within ten (10) days from October 24, 2007, and;
- Mr. Caris and Mr. Shieldes have now defaulted in their response to said "**Constructive Notice of Fraud**", and;
- Such default by Mr. Caris and Mr. Shieldes has now been deemed to be legal evidence of fraud.

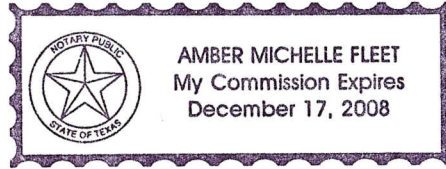
